

SHARING GENEROUSLY: EXERCISING OUR FAITH THROUGH STEWARDSHIP

Pledge income is essential to providing the staff, ministries, and programs that support our community, deepen our faith lives, and energize our care for one another. 2026 expenses will be higher, reflecting rising costs in the economy. It will take an 8% increase in revenue--most notably through increased pledges-- to meet increased costs and help achieve our goal of a balanced budget in 2026.

PLEDGES - 64% OF REVENUE

Committed last fall by households who made a pledge to St. Paul's for 2025

OFFERINGS, GIFTS AND OTHER INCOME - 9% OF REVENUE

Contributed by individuals through offerings and other gifts during the year and by The Circle of St. Paul's from its rummage sales

ENDOWMENT (MEMORIAL) FUNDS - 13% OF REVENUE

Earned income from invested legacy gifts dedicated to sustaining St. Paul's financial health

RENTAL INCOME - 9% OF REVENUE


Received from St. Paul's Nursery School (an independent entity) and other outside groups

TRANSFER FROM RESTRICTED FUNDS - 5% OF REVENUE

Limited reserve funds approved by St. Paul's Vestry to bridge the cost of current staff and programs until revenue matches expenses.

DECIDING HOW MUCH TO PLEDGE

Pledging is both a deeply personal choice and a spiritual practice involving our thankfulness for God's generosity in our lives. Our faith is strengthened and our commitment to each other reaffirmed in the practice of discerning what to share of our own financial resources. Last year, 132 households pledged \$632k toward St. Paul's budget of \$1.08m for 2025. The average pledge for 2025 is \$4,714. The average pledge needed for 2026 is \$5,090 to achieve a balanced budget. Whatever amount you feel called to give, with your pledge you join us in preserving St. Paul's traditions, sharing our blessings and exploring future possibilities for the St. Paul's community.
